


## Lean on Me Kentucky

Focus Group Summary Report

## **Cumberland Region**

The Cumberland Region Focus Group was held on June 13,2022 at 2:00 PM. Participants were recruited by Harlan Family Resource Youth Services Center (FRYSC), a longstanding PCAK Partner in Prevention in the Cumberland Region.

8 participants attended the focus group, representing community members and program participants. Participants from the Cumberland Region represented diverse experiences, cultures, and backgrounds. Many participants engaged throughout the focus group and 9 individuals completed the Survey Monkey after the focus group, resulting in 17 individuals' feedback reflected in this summary report.

1. What does community mean to you?



2. What can members of this community do to value, strengthen, and support parents and families?



3. What can members of this community do to respond when they see a family having a tough time?



4. What can members of this community do to help families make healthy and supportive connections?



5. It is important for children to interact in a positive way with others, understand and communicate their feelings, and regulate their behavior. How can members of this community help children develop these social and emotional skills?



6. What can members of this community do to connect families to available resources?

## **Themes**

Themes emerged throughout the narratives shared during our focus group questions and the Survey Monkey responses.

- 1. Service providers should be an empathetic, resourceful, listening ear for those in their community and beyond
- 2. Be more aware of available resources and care about those receiving services
- 3. Community should work together to provide safe and shared resources
