Focus Group Summary Report

Salt River Trail Region

The Salt River Trail Region Focus Group was held on June 21,2022 at 1:00 PM. Participants were recruited by Children's Alliance, a longstanding PCAK Partner in Prevention in the Salt River Trail Region.

10 participants attended the focus group, representing participants from a variety of professional backgrounds. Participants from the Northern Bluegrass Region represented diverse experiences, cultures, and backgrounds. Many participants engaged throughout the focus group and 0 individuals completed the Survey Monkey after the focus group, resulting in 10 individuals' feedback reflected in this summary report.



Focus group participants were asked to respond to the following 6 questions:



- 1. What does community mean to you?
- 2. What can members of this community do to value, strengthen, and support parents and families?



- 4. What can members of this community do to help families make healthy and supportive connections?
- 5. It is important for children to interact in a positive way with others, understand and communicate their feelings, and regulate their behavior. How can members of this community help children develop these social and emotional skills?
- 6. What can members of this community do to connect families to available resources?

Themes

Themes emerged throughout the narratives shared during our focus group questions and the Survey Monkey responses.

- 1. Increased value on shared views, cultures, and experiences
- 2. Create regularly updated information and resources accessible via print and online
- 3. Provide spaces that strengthen families and children, regardless of income
